Use this checklist as a tool for developing your church's Hephzibah62:4 ministry plan, specifically aimed at transforming the lives of vulnerable children in your community:

- ☐ Our ministry aligns with at least one of the Hephzibah62:4 key areas of engagement: Trauma-Informed Care, Sanctity of Human Life, Anti-Trafficking, Special Needs Ministry, Family Preservation, Foster Care, and Adoption. (See hephzibah.org for more information on these categories of engagement.)
- ☐ Our ministry plan documents supporting evidence of the need for this ministry (may use statistics and insights from MissionInsite*, other research, and anecdotal evidence from personal experience and conversations with key community practitioners).
- ☐ Our ministry is based in the local church but has the potential to impact the wider community.
- ☐ Our ministry draws in church attendees for hands-on involvement and creates discipleship opportunities both for those serving and those being served.
- ☐ Our ministry plan includes community collaboration and seeks to grow, strengthen and sustain partnerships with other local churches, non-profit organizations, child welfare offices, law enforcement agencies, and/or schools.
- ☐ Our ministry plan demonstrates how the ministry's financial needs are beyond the scope of the church's budget and the sacrificial giving ability of the congregation.
- ☐ Our ministry plan includes plans for sustainability, budget, timeline, and launch date.
